Hello everyone! We hope you are keeping well.

We are very pleased to announce we have started working with the Mayor of London's Culture Team to deliver the Dementia Friendly Venues Charter! The Mayor of London has launched the world's first Dementia Friendly Venues Charter for cultural public spaces in a drive to ensure that every Londoner with dementia and their carers have a dementia-friendly cultural venue on their doorstep. As part of this work, we are running a pilot assessment of cultural venues that have been accredited as being dementia-friendly.

Resonate Arts participants are working with artist and facilitator Seiwa Cunningham to develop Mystery Shopper roles. They will visit and assess how accessible and welcoming the venue is before sharing their experiences and feedback to help venues with improving their offer for people living with dementia. We hope to share some results in 2024!
