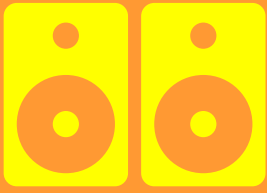


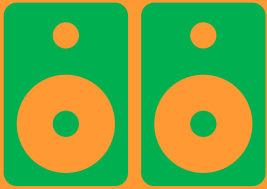
Reggae Music Makes Me Smile
